Professor Rolf-Dieter Heuer is an experimental particle physicist who served as Director-General of CERN, the European Organization for Nuclear Research, from January 2009 to December 2015. Heuer currently serves as the President of the German Physical Society and is also one of the seven members of the High Level Group of scientific advisors to the European Commission's Scientific Advice Mechanism (SAM). He is the designated President of the Council of SESAME (Synchrotron-Light for Experimental Science and Applications in the Middle East). Heuer is a member of several Academies of Sciences in Europe. Among his many honors, he received the Grand Cross 1st class of the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany and was appointed a *Chevalier de la Légion d'honneur* (Knight of the Legion of Honour) by the French Republic.
